FALL 2019 SCHOOL REFERENDUM A Bridge to the Future

Zumbrota-Mazeppa School District is moving forward with a new plan to renovate and expand existing facilities after hearing feedback from over 800 district residents – a majority of which indicated they would like a new plan put to vote. The new plan is focused on addressing the top concerns from the last referendum and breaks the proposed projects into three parts to be voted on separately:

QUESTION #1

Funds to expand and renovate existing learning spaces (incl. Career & Technical Ed, Special Education), improve safety and security, address required maintenance.

COST: \$38,585,000



QUESTION #2

Funds to build a new gymnasium in Mazeppa.

(Use current WPA – Works Progress Administration est. 1935 – gym space as a dedicated cafeteria.)

COST: \$3,350,000



QUESTION #3

Funds to build a new gymnasium in Zumbrota for physical education and athletic needs, as well as update athletic fields, parking and accessibility.

COST: \$4,945,000

THE NEW PLAN Ballot Question #1

SAFETY & SECURITY improvements addressed if this question is approved include:

Childcare Center

- Securing the main entrance/office

Elementary School

- Relocate and secure main entrance/office
- Create adequate health services space

Primary School

- Relocate and secure main entrance/office
- Create adequate health services space
- Separate student, parent and bus traffic for safer pick-up / drop-off
- Expand parking areas to reduce street parking

Middle/High School

- Relocate and secure main entrance/office
- Create adequate health services space
- Add new bus loop for improved safety and staff/event parking area

LEARNING SPACE remodels and additions addressed if this question is approved include:

Childcare Center

- Add two classrooms, one bathroom

Elementary School

- Add new classrooms and Special Education spaces
- Remodel existing classrooms to provide natural lighting and add collaboration spaces for flexible, project-based activities
- Renovate library
- Reconfigure band and choir rooms
- Expand food service and kitchen areas
- Repurpose old gymnasium into new cafeteria
- Remodel restrooms, locker rooms

Primary School

- Add classrooms to accommodate Early Childhood Program
- Renovate Special Education area to include sensory room
- Renovate existing library and office areas

Middle/High School

- Expand and remodel Career & Technical Education area, including new Metals/Project labs and Family & Consumer Science spaces
- Add new classrooms and library
- Repurpose existing office space for Special Education use

REQUIRED MAINTENANCE needs (district wide) funded with this new plan include:

- Overdue building repairs and updates to ceilings, floors, walls, doors, casework and HVAC systems, as well as fire alarms and sprinkler systems
- Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility updates
