Mazeppa Student Flu Clinic is from 9:00 am - 11:30 am.

Zumbrota Student Flu Clinic is from 12:30 pm - 2:30 pm.

Registration is required and is now open.

Parents will need to fill out one registration form for each student.

Registration deadline is October 8, 2018 at 11:00 pm.

Goodhue County Health & Human Services and Zumbrota-Mazeppa are partnering with Homeland Health to give flu shots to students during school. If the new FluMist nasal vaccine is available, that will be an option as well.

The vaccination will be billed to the child's insurance and will be provided at no cost to those without insurance.

If you question if your insurance will cover the immunization please call the number on the back of your card. Call to see if Homeland Health Services is covered.
