1. With help, I can *ask* and *answer* questions about details in a story. (Characters, setting, and major events)
2. With help, I can *retell* familiar stories.
3. I can *match* pictures to words in a story.
4. I can follow words *left to right, top to bottom, page by page*.
5. I can use kindergarten appropriate grammar when *writing* and *speaking* (upper/lower case letters, spacing, proper tenses, and punctuation).
6. I can *say* the names and sounds of all upper and lower case letters.
7. I can *recognize* and make rhyming words.
8. I can *sound out* the beginning, middle, and ending sounds in a CVC word.
9. I can *read* common high-frequency words with a purpose and understanding.
10. I can *tell, draw* and *write* about a topic.

11. I can *contribute* to a discussion in an appropriate way.

12. I can *recognize* common types of text. (story books, poems, common signs, and logos)
