- I can read and comprehend stories, dramas, and poems written at the seventh grade reading level.
- I can determine what the text says explicitly or infers. I can give textual support for my conclusions.
- I can determine themes of a text and analyze their development over the course of the text. I can summarize the key supporting details and ideas.
- I can analyze how particular elements of a story or drama interact over the course of the text. I can analyze the structure of texts and explain how the structure adds to its meaning (flashbacks, foreshadowing, hook, and cliffhanger).
