- Students will identify and describe geographic features in key world regions
- Students will analyze world regions in terms of their essential characteristics (economy, land use, government, and culture)
- Students will develop a contextual historical understanding of world regions
- Students will recognize the importance of local, regional, and world environmental issues
- Students will develop the understanding that cultures are based on a system of learned values and beliefs which lead to cultural diversity
