



SCHOOL BOARD WORK SESSION MONDAY, September 12, 2022

Member's present: Jason Lohmann, Jean Roth, Amanda Peters, Jim Wendt, Stephanie Miller and Angie Bredehoft

Also Present: Mr. Harvey, Mr. Brown, Ms Constantine and board clerk Amber Rasmussen.

Jason Lohmann called the meeting to order at 7PM.

Angie Bredehoft motioned to adopt the agenda as presented. Jean Roth seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

The following items were discussed.

- 1. Policy review: The following policies were reviewed, 709 Student Transportation Policy, 801 Equal Access to School Facilities, 807 Health and Safety Policy, 901 Community Education, 902 Use of School District Facilities and Equipment, 903 Visitors to the School District Buildings and Sites, 906 Community Notification of Predatory Offenders.
- 2. Brand Review Guide: Mr. Brown presented branding of the official logos of ZM Schools. He will ask BSN to include Carolina Blue and will bring it back to the next meeting for approval.
- 3. GAGA Pit: A GAGA pit is being installed at the Elementary in Mazeppa. The Mazeppa Lions have made a donation to make this possible. School is cost sharing the price of the pavement with the City of Mazeppa.
- 4. National Convention Policy Travel and Lodging: Mr. Brown is working with other HVL Activity Directors about what costs of conventions and travel the school covers for clubs such as FCCLA and

- FFA. Mr. Harvey suggested setting a total budget for each National Trip at \$3000 to help defer the cost of travel/food/lodging. This will be brought back for approval at the next board meeting.
- 5. Fundraising by Booster Clubs Using Sponsors to Support Our Programs: Mr. Harvey asked if it would be OK for Booster Clubs to produce Sporting Event Fliers. This will be brought back to a future meeting.
- 6. Beginning of the year update: Staffing Still short paraprofessionals, Lunch short 2 positions, implementing Local Foods Thursdays Bussing met with admin team today to update timing and expectations. Palmer has hired 9 new drivers that are currently getting licensed. Jessica Kohn will get information to Mr. Harvey about "Where's My Bus" a tracking system parents can use to see when their bus will arrive.
- 7. September Levy to the Maximum: At the next board meeting we will submit to Levy to the maximum. The official levy certification will be at the Truth in Taxation meeting in December.
- 8. Construction Update: Some flooring still needs to be finished. Punch list items will then start and could take up to 10 months.
- 9. Open House information: Open house will start at 9AM this Saturday. Tours will be given of the MSHS at 9:20 and the Elementary at 10:30. Lunch will be available for purchase in the cafeteria at 11am. 12 noon kickoff against Cannon Falls.

Jean Roth motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:07 PM. Angie Bredehoft seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.
